ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ANTHONY J. MARTINEZ, P.A.

The undersigned natural person, who is licensed or otherwise legally authorized to practice the profession of medicine in the State of Florida, hereby associate himself with the intention of forming a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is Anthony J. Martinez, P.A.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual or until dissolved on a vote of the shareholders as hereafter provided.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

The purpose of the corporation is to practice the profession of medicine.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

The total number of shares of capital stock which the corporation shall be authorized to issue is 100 shares. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock, and shall have a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

ARTICLE V. CAPITALIZATION

The amount of capital with which the corporation will begin to practice the profession of practicing medicine is not less than \$100.00.

ARTICLE VI. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE VII. CORPORATE POWERS

The corporation shall have all the rights and powers on or hereafter conferred on professional corporations by the laws of the State of Florida, including, but not limited to, the following:

1. To transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of Florida;
2. To do such other things as are incidental to the foregoing or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish the foregoing.

ARTICLE VIII. SUBSCRIBERS

The initial directors shall hold office until their successors are elected and qualify as provided in the bylaws. Thereafter the term of office of each director shall be one year and until the election and qualification of a successor. ARTICLE X. BYLAWS

The initial directors shall submit the proposed bylaws to the shareholders at a meeting to be held for that purpose not more than ten (10) days following the issuance of the Certificate of Incorporation. Following the adoption of bylaws by unanimous vote, the internal affairs of the corporation are to be regulated and managed in accordance with such bylaws.

ARTICLE XI. DISSOLUTION

The corporation may be dissolved at any time by unanimous written consent of the shareholders. On dissolution, the corporate property and assets shall, after payment of all debts of the corporation, be distributed to the shareholders pro rata, each shareholder to participate in the distribution in direct proportion to the number of shares held by them.
