

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF



HOWARD, WINSLOW PROPERTIES, INC.

I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, being a natural person competent to contract, hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file these articles for the purpose of becoming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

Name of Corporation and Principal Office

The name of the corporation shall be Howard, Winslow Properties, Inc. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 2216 East Olive Road, Suite 103, Pensacola, Florida, 32514, and the mailing address is P. O. Box 10391, Pensacola, Florida, 32524-0391.

ARTICLE II

Effective Date of Incorporation

The effective date of incorporation of Howard, Winslow Properties, Inc., is hereby declared to be August 22, 2000.

ARTICLE III

Duration

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, commencing on the 22nd day of August, 2000.

ARTICLE IV

Purpose

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business, both within and without the State of Florida, including, but not limited to, buying, selling, leasing, mortgaging and holding both improved and unimproved real property; construction, development, operation, holding, leasing and selling of commercial and residential projects; and participating generally in the acquisition, holding, development, renting, mortgaging and selling of real property and the construction and/or remodelling of improvements thereon.

ARTICLE VIII

Initial Board of Directors

The corporation shall have one director initially. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as provided in the By-Laws of the corporation, but the number of directors of the corporation shall not be less than one nor more than seven. These Articles of Incorporation may be amended upon any proposed amendment receiving the affirmative vote of the holders of a majority of the shares then cutstanding at any regular or special meeting of the stockholders, upon advance notice given of the change to be made. Upon approval by the Secretary of State, any such amendment shall become and be taken as a part of the original Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE XII

By-Laws
