

## ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF I-ACADEMY, INC.



Pursuant to the provisions of §607.1003(6), Fla. Stat., the Florida Business Corporation Act, i-Academy, Inc., a Florida corporation, does hereby amend its Articles of Incorporation, as follows:

- 1. The name of the corporation is i-Academy, Inc.
