ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
Multi-Value Data Management, Inc.

The undersigned persons, acting as incorporators of a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I
CORPORATE NAME

The name of this corporation is Multi-Value Data Management, Inc..

ARTICLE II
INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III
SHARES

The total number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 500 shares with no par value

ARTICLE IV
PURPOSE

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful activity permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE V
DIRECTORS

The person/s constituting the initial Board of Directors is Richard Macker. After the initial Board of Directors, the Board shall consist of such number of directors as shall be determined by the shareholders at their Annual Meeting at which time the Directors are appointed &/or elected.

ARTICLE VI LIABILITY OF DIRECTORS

To the fullest extent permitted by law, no director of this corporation shall be personally liable to the corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of any duty owed to the corporation or its shareholders, except that a director may be held personally liable for:

1. breaches of the duty of loyalty,
2. acts or omissions not in good faith of which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law,
3. declaration of unlawful dividends or unlawful stock repurchases or redemptions,
4. a transaction from which the director derives an improper personal benefit.

Any director or officer who is involved in litigation or other proceeding by reason of his or her position as a director or officer of this corporation shall be indemnified and held harmless by the corporation to the fullest extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE VII OTHER PROVISIONS

Preemptive Rights. The corporation elects to have preemptive rights so that each shareholder has the right to acquire a proportional amount of any shares that are issued.

Director or Officer Interest. In the absence of fraud, no transaction between (a) this corporation and (b) any other association, corporation or any director or officer of this corporation individually, shall be affected by the fact that any director or officer of this corporation is individually a party to the transaction or is interested in or is a director or officer of such other association or corporation.

Stock Transfer Restriction. No Shareholder of this corporation shall sell any shares of stock held by him or her in this corporation without first offering to sell such stock to the corporation on the same terms and conditions and at the price offered in good faith and in writing, by any proposed purchaser. The written offer by such proposed purchaser shall be delivered to the corporation the time the stock is offered to the corporation for sale. The corporation shall have the right to accept the offer any time within thirty (30) days






