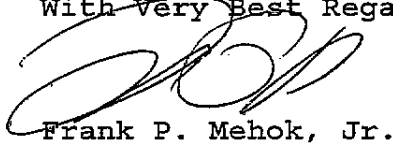

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ROBERT D. LA BAR, P.A.

The undersigned, who is duly licensed to practice the profession of accounting in the State of Florida, desires to form a professional corporation pursuant to Section 621 of Florida Statutes for the purpose of rendering accounting services, and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I- NAME

The name of the corporation shall be ROBERT D. LA BAR, P.A.

ARTICLE II- NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

1. To engage in every phase and aspect of the business of rendering the same accounting services to the public that an accountant, duly licensed under the laws of the State of Florida is authorized to render, provided such accounting services shall be rendered only through officers, employees and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to engage in the practice of accounting within the State of Florida.
