## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporators, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

BAY PUBLICATIONS, INC.

### ARTICLE II - PRINCIPLE OFFICE

The principle place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

### ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to engage in any activity or business under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida's General Corporation Act.

### ARTICLE IV - PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of the duration of this corporation is perpetually, commencing on the date of execution and acknowledgment of these articles or the earliest date allowable by the division of corporations, unless dissolved according to law.

### ARTICLE V - BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the Shareholders.

A special meeting of the shareholders shall be held, upon the call of the President, for the purpose of completing the organization of the corporation and the adoption of the bylaws.

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#### ARTICLE VI - SHARES

The number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 10,000 shares of common stock having a \$1.00 par value per share.

#### ARTICLE VII - RESTRICTIONS ON TRANSFER OF STOCK

Shares of capital stock of this corporation shall be issued initially to the following person(s) in the amount set opposite of their name:

#### ARTICLE VIII - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, call, or series as that which he/she already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof at the price at which it is offered to others.

#### ARTICLE IX - DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have one director, initially, and the number of directors may increase or decrease by the amendment of the bylaws of the corporation but in no case be less than one.






