ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JARMG, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation: OD SEP 1 PH W. 32

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is:

JARMG, INC.

ARTICLE II - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general character and nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

To transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida General Corporations Act.

ARTICLE III - CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, each share having a par value of one (\$1.00) Dollar currency of the United States of America.
