



**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
THE AVALON PROFESSIONAL GROUP, INC.**

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of THE AVALON PROFESSIONAL GROUP, INC., under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is:


ARTICLE VIII. BYLAWS

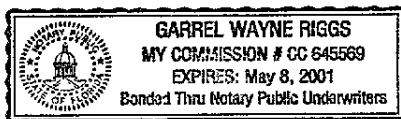
