We, the undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, natural persons competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is any activity or business permitted under the Laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

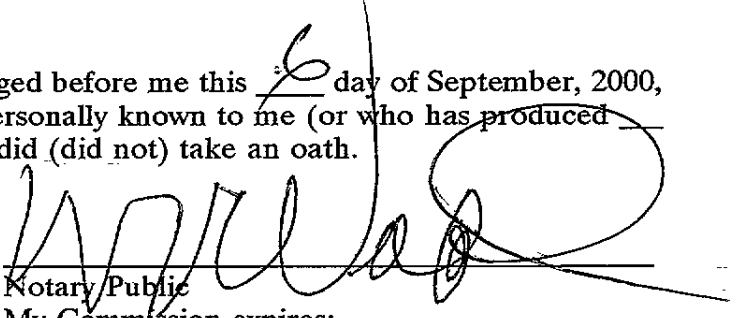

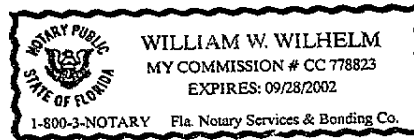
