ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PHILLIPS INVESTMENTS, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME:

The name of this corporation is: PHILLIPS INVESTMENTS, INC., hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II - DURATION:
