**ARTICLES OF CORPORATION
LONG INVESTMENTS AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION**

**ARTICLE ONE
NAME**

The name of the corporation is Long Investments and Development Corporation.

ARTICLE TWO

Corporation's Principal Office Address, 1712 N.E. Waldo Road, Suite B, Gainesville, County of Alachua, State of Florida, 32609.

**ARTICLE THREE
DURATION**

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

**ARTICLE FOUR
PURPOSE**

The nature of the business, or objects or purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted or carried on are:

To purchase, receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in, and in all other ways acquire, invest, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment own hold for investment or otherwise use enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow guarantee, contract in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign, and in all other ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all other ways (whether like or unlike the foregoing), deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal or mixed, tangible and intangible, wherever situated and however held including but not limited to, money, credits, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, scripts, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property (improved and unimproved), and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance therein and appurtenance thereto, including, but not limited to, mineral, oil, gas, and water rights. All or any part of any going business and its incidents, franchises, subsidiaries, charters, concessions, grants, rights, powers or privileges, granted or conferred by any government or subdivision of agency, thereof, and any interest in or part of any of the foregoing, and to exercise in respect thereof all of the rights, powers, privileges, and immunities of individual owners or holders thereof;

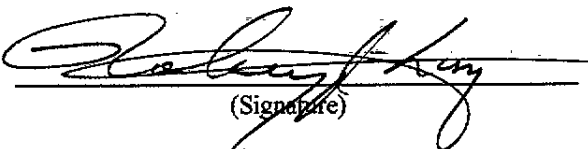
