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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BOCT 16 M 9:23 The undersigned, under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Artic of Incorporation for such corporation:

<u>ARTICLE I - NAME</u>

The name of the corporation is Lighting Specialists, Inc.

<u>ARTICLE II - TERM OF EXISTENCE</u>

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

- 1. This corporation is organized to transact any lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida, and
- 2. To do such other things as are incidental to the foregoing, or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish the foregoing.

ARTICLE IV - AUTHORIZED SHARES

The aggregate number of shares that the corporation shall have the authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) shares of capital stock for the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar per share.
