ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

INNRCOM COMMUNICATIONS CORP.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of INNRCOM COMMUNICATIONS CORP. under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

INNRCOM COMMUNICATIONS CORP.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III. COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation will commence on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSE

This corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and Florida.

ARTICLE V. AUTHORIZED SHARES

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of Common Stock with a par value of \$.01 per share. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be fixed by the board of directors and such consideration may consist of any tangible or intangible property or benefit to the corporation, including cash, promissory notes, services performed, promises to perform services evidenced by

a written contract, or other securities of the corporation, with a value, in the judgment of the directors, equivalent to or greater than the full value of the shares.

Thereafter, every amendment shall be approved by the board of directors, proposed by them to the shareholders, and approved at a shareholders' meeting by the holders of a majority of the shares entitled to vote on the matter or in such other manner as may be provided by law.
