ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned Subscriber(s) to these Articles of Incorporation, natural person(s) competent to contract, hereby form(s) a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is LINCOURT RX, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and shall be effective upon filing of the Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

- A. To engaged in the business of pharmaceutical sales together with any and all ancillary and related matters thereto.
- B. To acquire by purchase, lease, or otherwise, lands and interests in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop, and manage any real estate so acquired, and to erect or cause to be erected on any lands owned, held, or occupied by the corporation, buildings or other structures, public or private, with appurtenances, and to manage, operate, lease, rent, rebuild, enlarge, alter, or improve any buildings or other structures, now or hereafter erected on any lands so owned, held, or occupied, and

- C. To engage in the retail, wholesale, and manufacturing business in any and all fields and to do all things necessary to engage in any type of business generally.
- D. To acquire, by purchase, lease, manufacture, or otherwise, any personal property deemed necessary or useful in the equipment, furnishings, improvement, development, or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held, or occupied by the corporation, to invest, trade, and deal in any personal property deemed beneficial to the corporation, and to lease, rent, encumber, or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the corporation.
- E. To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidences of indebtedness, and execute such mortgages, transfers of corporate property, or other instruments to secure the payment of corporate indebtedness as required.
- F. To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business, including re-purchase of its own shares.

- G. To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state of government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.
- H.
