ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of this corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is NETHEALTHCO.COM, INC.

ARTICLE II. DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE III. MAILING ADDRESS OF BUSINESS
