ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned, do hereby associate ourselves together, for the purpose of becoming a corporation, operating for profit by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida appertaining and providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of a corporation operating for profit, and do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge and file these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of becoming such a corporation for profit and do hereby declare, state and certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be: DARA MORTGAGE SERVICES, INC.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- 1. To act as a correspondent mortgage lender; to take, acquire, buy, hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, convey, mortgage, hypothecate, exchange, improve and otherwise deal in and dispose of real and personal property or any interest or rights therein; to buy, sell, assign, convey, satisfy, release and cancel liens upon personal and real property; to draw, accept, endorse, discount and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, stocks, bonds, debentures and other negotiable instruments of whatsoever nature and to secure the same by mortgage or otherwise on property, real and personal.
- 2. To borrow money and contract debts necessary for the transaction of the business of the corporation, or for the exercise of its corporation rights, privileges and franchises or for any other lawful purpose; to issue bonds, promissory notes, stock, bills of exchange, debentures and other obligations and the evidences of indebtedness, payable at specified time or times, or payable upon the happening of a specified event or events, secured or unsecured, from time to time

or for any of the other objects of this business, and generally transact business concerning the same.

- 3. To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to hold for investment, and to own, hold, sell, vote and handle shares of stocks and bonds in other corporations.
