

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I - NAME

_____ The name of the corporation is POSITIVE WEB, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

_____ This corporation is organized for the purpose of performing and engaging in all lawful pursuits and the purpose of the corporation shall be carried out only through officers, employees, and agents of the corporation.

ARTICLE III - REGISTERED OFFICE

_____ The initial address of the registered office of this Corporation is 3211 Salinas Way, Miramar, Florida 33025.

ARTICLE IV - DURATION

_____ The Duration of the corporation is a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V - POWERS OF CORPORATION

_____ The Corporation shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary or convenient to carry out its business and affairs, subject to any limitations or restrictions imposed by applicable law or these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE VI - CAPITAL STOCK

_____The maximum number of shares that this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is ONE THOUSAND (1,000) shares of common stock, each share having the par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00).

The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may authorize the issuance from time to time of shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, or securities convertible into shares of its stock of any class, whether now or hereafter authorized, for such consideration as the Board of Director(s) may deem advisable, subject to such restrictions or limitations, if any, as may be set forth in the bylaws of the Corporation.

The Board of Director(s) of the Corporation may, by Restated Articles of incorporation, classify or reclassify any un-issued stock from time to time by setting or changing the preferences, conversions or other rights, voting powers, restrictions, limitations as to dividends, qualifications, or term or conditions of redemption of the stock.

"The shares of stock represented by this certificate cannot be transferred if such transfer would void the election of the Corporation to be taxed under Sub-Chapter S of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended."



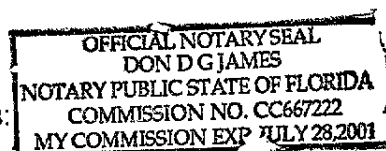

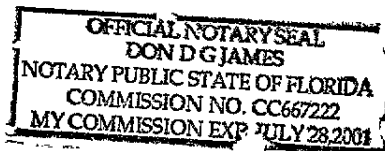
