ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Florida Factory Outlet Model Center, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation, and the object and purposes to be promoted and carried on, are as follows:

- A. To carry on the business of marketing manufactured homes, mobile homes, recreational vehicles, insurance, real estate and related products and services.
- B. To purchase, improve, rent, lease, own, mortgage, hold, enjoy, maintain, sell and develop real property.
- C. To manufacture, build, erect, alter and repair all kinds of building, structures and articles of property.
- D. To act as factor or agent of persons, firms, partnerships or corporations in the negotiations of the sale of property, both real and personal, for commission or compensation.
- E. To buy, sell, own, hold and deal in personal property of any and all kinds.
- F. To manufacture, buy, sell, deal in, export and import every kind or description of material, merchandise, product or other property and to act as purchasing and selling agents therefor.
- G. To acquire the good will of any person, firm, business or corporation, and their rights, properties, patents, grants, concessions, trade names, distinctive marks, processes and other property rights; and to hold, use, operate under and sell the same.
- H. To establish, buy, sell, conduct, hire, lease or maintain warehouses and storage facilities of every description.
- I. To manufacture, buy, sell, import, hire and lease, and generally deal in machinery, materials, implements and conveyances suitable for use in connection with the operation of the business of this corporation.

- J. To both lend and borrow money and contract debts, when necessary for the transaction of its business or for the exercise of its corporate rights, privileges of franchises, or for any other lawful purpose of its incorporation.
- K. To issue bonds, promissory notes, bills of exchange, debentures or other obligations and evidences of indebtedness, payable at a specified time, or payable upon the happening of a specified event, whether secured by a mortgage, pledge or otherwise, or unsecured, for money borrowed or in payment of property purchased or acquired, or any other lawful objects.
- L. To guarantee, purchase, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the shares of capital stock, or any bonds, securities, or evidences of indebtedness created by any other State or government, and while the owner of such stock shall exercise all the rights, powers, and privileges of ownership including the right to vote thereon.
- M. To conduct business, have one or more offices, and hold, purchase, mortgage, and convey real and personal property in this state.
- N. To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects as principal factor, agent, contractor or otherwise, association or corporation.
- 0. To engage in and act as consultant, personnel and management trainer and advisor to businesses and associations of all types and kinds.
- P. To do all and everything necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the objects enumerated herein, or necessary or incidental to the specific powers and privileges which are, can be or may be granted to corporations under the laws of the State Of Florida, and in that connection to carry on any lawful business necessary or incidental to the attainment of the objects of the corporation, whether or not such business is similar in nature to the objects set forth herein.

ARTICLE III

The maximum number of shares of stock that this corporation shall be authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be 1,000 shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per shares.

ARTICLE IV

This corporation shall have perpetual existence unless sooner dissolved by law.

Each officer and director shall hold office until he shall be elected and qualified, provided, however, that a majority of stockholders at either a regular or special meeting may remove any officer or director with or without cause.
