ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MORGAN ANDREW, INC.

I, RONALD J. DIXON, being of legal age, do hereby sign these presents for the purposes of becoming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida authorizing the formation of corporations, as the incorporator, and whose residence address is: 2863 Northeast 26th Place, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33306.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: MORGAN ANDREW, INC.

The general nature of the business and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on are to do any and all of the things herein mentioned, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, viz:

- A. Establishment and operation of any lawful business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida, including the purchase and sale of real and personal property, including the management thereof.
- B. - I. In any manner to acquire, enjoy, utilize and to dispose of patents, copyrights and trademarks, and any license or other interest therein and thereunder.
- To purchase, subscribe for or otherwise acquire, become interested in, deal in and with, invest in, hold, pledge, sell, mortgage, lend money on, exchange or otherwise dispose of or turn to account or realize upon as owner, agent, broker or factor, all securities, including Stocks, Bonds, Debentures, of Mortgages, Notes, evidencing shares of or interest in common law Trusts, Trusts and Trust Estates or associations, Certificates of Trust or beneficial interests in Trusts, Mortgages, Contracts and other instruments, securities and rights; to investigate and report with respect to; and to undertake, carry on, aid, assist or participate in the organization, liquidation or reorganization of financial, commercial, mercantile, manufacturing, industrial or other business concerns, firms, associations and corporations; to institute, participate in or promote commercial, mercantile financial and industrial enterprises and operations.
