

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SAINT MALO, INC.



The undersigned hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is: SAINT MALO, INC.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office and a mailing address of the corporation is as follows:

ARTICLE III - COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

The corporation shall commence its corporate existence on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation, and shall exist perpetually thereafter until dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the purpose of transacting any and all lawful business.

ARTICLE V - AUTHORIZED SHARES

The corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock.
