



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BLU DOG BAKERY, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation hereby comes to form a corporation for profit under the Statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges and immunities of such corporation.

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation shall be BLU DOG BAKERY, INC.

ARTICLE II NATURE OF BUSINESS

The corporation shall be authorized to engage in the business of bakery, catering, and retail and wholesale food sales and any other lawful activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III CAPITAL STOCK

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of one thousand (1,000) shares of common stock of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value, fully paid and non-assessable. The whole or any part of the capital stock of this corporation may be paid for in lawful money of the United States of America or in property, labor or services at a just valuation to be fixed by the Director(s).

ARTICLE IV AMOUNT OF CAPITAL NECESSARY TO BEGIN BUSINESS

The amount of capital with which the corporation shall begin business shall not be less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

ARTICLE V TERM OF EXISTENCE

The corporation shall have perpetual existence beginning

December 1, 2000.

ARTICLE VI PRINCIPLE PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principle place of business of the corporation shall be in Palm Beach County, Florida, and its principle office shall be at 724 Espanola Way, #4, Miami Beach, Florida, 33139 or at such other places within the State as the Board of Directors shall by appropriate action hereafter from time to time determine.
