ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>OF</u>

NORTON FOLGATE, INC.

ARTICLE 12-22-00

NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of this corporation is NORTON FOLGATE, INC. and its principal address is 13105 Vanderbilt Drive, No. 402, Naples, Florida 34110.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of execution of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

This corporation is organized to engage in the business of acquiring real property. developing land, arranging for construction and renovation and selling real property, and for all other purposes allowed a Florida corporation.

ARTICLE IV

CAPITAL STOCK

The corporation is authorized to issue 7,500 shares of One Dollar (\$1.00) par value common stock.

ARTICLE V

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

ARTICLE VIII

BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal By-Laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

ARTICLE IX

SHAREHOLDER QUORUM

Sixty percent of the shares entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of the shareholders.

ARTICLE X

APPROVAL OF SHAREHOLDERS REQUIRED FOR MERGER

The approval of the shareholders of this corporation to any plan of merger is required, even if that approval is not required by law.

ARTICLE XI

NO REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law against all expenses, costs, damages and attorneys' fees reasonably incurred for any action or inaction in connection with the corporation except for a criminal act, gross negligence or willful misconduct.

An officer or director shall not be liable to the corporation for any loss or damage sustained by it for any action taken or omitted by him if he in good faith exercised the care of a prudent man, in good faith acted or failed to act based upon advice of counsel

for the corporation or on the books and records of the corporation, or followed what he believed to be sound accounting and business practice.

ARTICLE XIII

PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder upon the issuance or sale of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind or class as that which he already owns, shall have the preemptive right to purchase his pro rata share (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE XIV

AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment to them by a three-quarter vote of the shareholders.


