ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT
TO
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
RICK CASE CYCLES, INC.

The following provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of Rick Case Cycles, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), filed with the Department of State on January 16, 2001, under document number P01000005669, be and they are hereby amended as shown below:


- 1. Article VI of the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall have initially two (2) directors. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time as determined by the By-Laws."

The foregoing amendment was adopted by a Joint Consent Action of the Board of Directors of the Corporation, dated the 6th day of November, 2020. There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendment.
