ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PINNACLE ROOFING, INC.

The undersigned, desiring to form a corporation under Chapter 607, the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby certify:

Article 1 - Name

The name of this corporation (which is hereinafter called the "Corporation") shall be:

Pinnacle Roofing, Inc.

and the principal place of business will be 58 Laurie Drive, Fort Walton Beach, FL 32548 and the mailing address will be 58 Laurie Drive, Fort Walton Beach, FL 32548.

Article 2 - Commencement and Duration

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation by the Secretary of State. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

Article 3 - Purpose

The purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is formed are for the purpose of Roof contracting and engaging in the transaction of any and all business activities permitted under the laws of Florida and the United States of America.

Article 4 - Capital Stock

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation is authorized to issue is 100 shares of common stock with a par value of One Dollar per share.

Article 5 - Preemptive Rights

Article 10 - Incorporator
