In compliance with the requirements of F.S. Chapter 607, the undersigned, being a natural person, hereby acts as an incorporator in adopting and filing the following articles of incorporation for the purpose of organizing a business corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation ("Corporation") is PRINT TO FIT, INC.

ARTICLE II

The existence of the Corporation shall begin on the date of the filing of these articles of incorporation. This corporation shall engage in any lawful business, but its initial purpose shall be to engage in the business of screen printing.

ARTICLE III

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 315 N. Bridge Street, LaBelle, 33935, Hendry County Florida.

ARTICLE IV

The maximum number of shares this Corporation is authorized to issue is 1000 par value \$1.00 per share, all of which shall be Common Shares. All Common Shares shall be identical with each other in every respect and the holders of Common Shares shall be entitled to one vote for each share on all matters on which shareholders have the right to vote.

ARTICLE V

Therefore, The Transferability of This Certificate is Restricted Until It Is Determined By The Corporation That Any Proposed Transfer Will Not Adversely Affect The Exemptions Relied Upon."

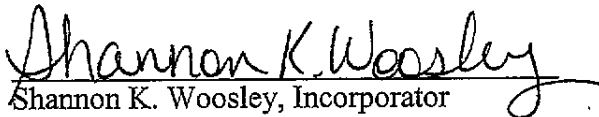

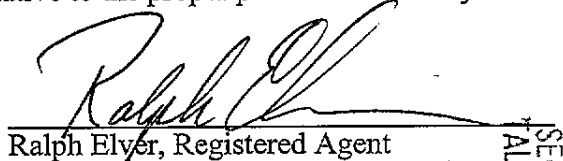
