urpose of form. A person who is equired to file an information return with ne IRS must get your correct taxpayer lentification number (TIN) to report, for xample, income paid to you, real estate ansactions, mortgage interest you paid, cquisition or abandonment of secured roperty, cancellation of debt, or ontributions you made to an IRA

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. erson (including a resident alien), to give our correct TIN to the person requesting (the requester) and, when applicable, to:

- 1. Certify the TIN you are giving is orrect (or you are waiting for a number to e issued).
- 2. Certify you are not subject to backup ithholding, or
- Claim exemption from backup ithholding if you are a U.S. exempt payee.

What is backup withholding? Persons making certain payments to you must withhold and pay to the IRS 31% of such payments under certain conditions. This payments under certain conductors. This is called "backup withholding." Payments that may be subject to backup withholding include interest, dividends, broker and barter exchange transactions, rents, royalties, nonemployee pay, and certain-payments from fishing boat operators. Real estate transactions are not subject to backup withholding.

If you give the requester your correct TIN, make the proper certifications, and report all your taxable interest and dividends on your tax return, payments you receive will not be subject to backup withholding. Payments you receive will be subject to backup withholding if:

- 1. You do not furnish your TIN to the
- requester, or
 2. You do not certify your TIN when required (see the Part III instructions on page 2 for details), or

3. The IRS tells the requester that you furnished an incorrect TIN, or

4. The IRS tells you that you are subject to backup withholding because you did not report all your interest and dividends on your tax return (for reportable interest and dividends only), or

Penalties

Failure to furnish TIN. If you fail to furnish your correct TIN to a requester, you are subject to a penalty of \$50 for each such failure unless your failure is due to reasonable cause and not to willful nealect.

Civil penalty for false information with respect to withholding, if you make a false statement with no reasonable basis that results in no backup withholding, you are subject to a \$500 penalty.

Criminal penalty for falsifying information. Willfully falsifying certifications or affirmations may subject you to criminal penalties including fines and/or imprisonment.

Misuse of TINs. if the requester discloses or uses TINs in violation of Federal law, the requester may be subject to civil and criminal penalties.
