Enclosed please find Jingmen, Inc., check 1027 in the amount of \$300.

I recently discovered that Jingmen, Inc., had not been reinstated when our corporation's attorney whom was filing a legal complaint on behalf of Jingmen, Inc., advised me of that fact.

Slightly over a year ago, our corporation changed its mailing address (from 2789 S. Oakland Forest Park Dr., Oakland Park, FL) to 3067 Bayberry Way, Margate, FL 33063 which is our current mailing address. This may partially explain why some of the notices were not received. During that time there was a tremendous disruption in receiving mail that was to be forwarded to our new mailing address. At least \$10,000+ in account payables due our corporation, as well as other important mail that was allegedly mailed, was never received during a 2-3 months period immediately after our change in mailing address was given to the US Post Office.

Our Corporation which is two years old this February experienced profitable sales in our first year of operation and then experienced an increase in sales of over 300% before the end of the second year. Thus, had we received the reinstatement notices, it would have been pointless to have intentionally threatened the ongoing viability of a very profitable and promising concern by intentionally not timely paying reinstatement fees.

Let me absolutely assure you that had we received the necessary reinstatement forms, it is a virtual impossibility that all reinstatement fees would not have been paid in full and on time.

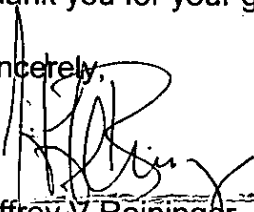
