The undersigned, acting on behalf of The Overall Tenant Advisory Council, a Florida Not For Profit corporation, a Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the Corporation is, BLUE SEAL CLEANING, Inc. Company.

<u>ARTICLE II – TERM OF EXISTENCE</u>

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III – DATE OF COMMENCEMENT
