stock or bonds, of this corporation and to draw, make, accept endorse, discount, execute, and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, warrants, instruments, or obligations of the corporation, from time to time, for any of the objects or purposes of the corporation without restriction or limit as to amount.

- (b) To engage in any lawful business; to do all and everything necessary, suitable, or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, attainment of any of the objectives, or the exercise of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in conjunction with other corporations, firms or individuals, and either as principals or agents, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things incidental or pertinent to or growing out of or connected with the above mentioned objectives, purposes, or powers.
