## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

The undersigned, desiring to organize a professional service organization for the Purposes hereinafter listed, pursuant to the Professional Service Corporation

ACT AND ACT A

## ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is South Florida Medical Referrals, Inc. (The "Corporation").

### <u>ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE</u>

The Principal office of the corporation is 2603 N. Dixie Hwy. #153, Wilton Manors, FL 33334

# ARTICLE III – PURPOSE

The general nature of the business to be transacted at the corporation shall be:

- (a) To provide medical referrals to the South Florida Residents. These referrals consist of physicians, medical supplies, medical transportation, chiropractors, and any medical professional that provides services for the well being seeking medical treatment.
