ARTICLE I

Name and Duration

The name of the Corporation is Photographic Journeys, Inc. The duration of the Corporation is perpetual. The effective date upon which this Corporation shall come into existence shall be the date these Articles are filed by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE II

Bylaws
