

# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BLACK BUSINESS, INC.

The undersigned, acting as sole incorporator, does hereby desire to form a corporation for profit pursuant to the Florida Business Corporation Act and does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

# Article 1 - Name of Corporation

The Name of the corporation shall be BLACK BUSINESS, INC.

# Article II - Term of Existence

The corporation shall commence its corporate existence upon the execution of these Articles of Incorporation and shall exist perpetually.

### Article III – General Purpose

The general purpose for which the corporation is organized shall be to manufacture, construct, purchase, or otherwise acquire, dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, and deal in and with products, goods, wares, merchandise, real and personal property and services of every kind, class, and description. It is intended that the corporation is organized for and may conduct and transact any and all lawful business authorized and not prohibited by the Florida Business Corporation Act, as the same may be, from time to time, amended.

#### Article IV - Capital Stock

The aggregate number of shares for which the corporation shall have authority to issue is five thousand (5,000) shares of preferred stock par value, one cent (\$.01) per share, and Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of common stock, par value one cent (\$.01) per share.

#### Article V – Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 390 North Orange Avenue, Suite 2180, Orlando, Florida 32801 and the name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at that address is Ometrias Deon Long.

The power to adopt, amend, or repeal the Bylaws for the management of the corporation shall be vested solely in the shareholders of the corporation.

#### **Article IX – Indemnification**

The corporation shall indemnify its directors, officers, employees and agents to the full extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act.


