The name of the corporation is Yamout Enterprises Inc..

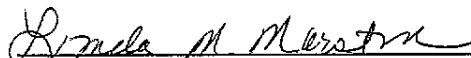

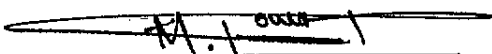

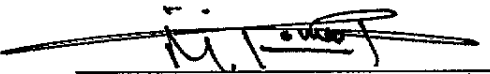
