 - Reorganization, merger or consolidation of the corporation; В.
- Sale, lease or exchange of the major portion of the property or assets of the C. corporation; or
 - Dissolution of the corporation. D.

ARTICLE VII Term of Existence

This corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE VIII Directors

- The business of the corporation shall be managed initially by a board of two (02) director(s). The number of directors may be, as provided in the bylaws, increased or decreased, but shall never be less than one (1) director.
 - The entire Board of Directors, or any individual director, may be removed from В.

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office without assignment of cause by affirmative vote of a majority of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote. Directors who are not stockholders may be removed for cause by a majority vote of all classes of stock entitled to vote. Any director who is also a stockholder may be removed for cause by the affirmative vote of a majority of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote exclusive of his own shares of stock.

- C. Any vacancy on the Board of Directors shall be filled by the shareholders at a regular or special meeting called for that purpose. A shareholder removed as a director for cause shall not be entitled to vote to fill his own vacancy by voting for himself without prior approval secured by the affirmative vote of a majority of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote, exclusive of his own shares of stock.
- D. Members of the Board of Directors or an Executive Committee shall be deemed present at a meeting if a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting can hear each other is used.

ARTICLE IX Effective Date

The date that corporate existence shall begin is the date of filing of these Articles with the Department of State. This election is pursuant to Florida Statute 607.0123.

ARTICLE X Registered Office and Registered Agent
