Re; 2002 Corporate Report for Sopchoppy Outfitters/Backwoods Adventures, Inc.

The original annual report form was given to our accountant last winter, who usually handles this type of activity for us. He, during 2002, successively underwent coronary by-pass stenting following a myocardial infarction, experimental surgery for stenting a cerebral aneurysm, (at Shands/Gainesville,) which was successful, but was unfortunately followed by a stroke which resulted in a right-sided paralysis which required extensive physical therapy. That the Annual Report was the only item we have found that did not get taken care of by him, we consider quite remarkable.

The situation was further complicated by the manager we hired in April 2002, who took over handling of the mail starting in May. She quit with great flourish in November and is currently suing us under every venue available, on the grounds of many "problems" that she in fact created herself. She apparently does not believe that she can be held responsible for any of her actions or omissions as manager in spite of her contract with us. The late notices and Notice of Dissolution that the Division of Corporations routinely sends out (and presumably did in this case,) are only a few of many important documents (not to mention money,) that disappeared and/or were not appropriately handled during her tenure as manager. We are at this point still considering whether to pursue civil or criminal action against her, but needless to say, maintaining our corporate status is vital to our investors under the current circumstances. We of course will add any further economic losses (such as the late fee,) to our action against her, but the reality is the main reason she is suing us is because she has apparently spent most of the money gained from her last (successful) legal action, and apparently has few or no remaining assets. For this reason, we the owners of Sopchoppy Outfitters/Backwoods Adventures are requesting waiver of the reinstatement fee, as we did not in fact receive any of the notices sent.
