



Please be advised that the above referenced corporation never received the initial 2002 Uniform Business Report.

Woodstock Farm of Jupiter, Inc., was retaining the service of an accountant, who stated, as well, that the Uniform Business Report was never received.

We assumed that everything was taking care of, since we did not receive any other correspondence from the Department of State.


