The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be The BlackSmith Development & Investments Corporation.

The primary purpose of this corporation are as following:
