ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SPECIALIZED ON-SITE CARE MANAGEMENT, INC.

Pursuant to Sections 607.1001 and 607.1006, Florida Statutes, Specialized On-Site Care Management, Inc., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation"), hereby adopts these Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation (the "Amendment") for the purpose of amending its Articles of Incorporation as follows:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is Specialized On-Site Care Management, Inc.
