ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF GREATER JACKSONVILLE NURSES REGISTRY, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, Doris V. Wanger, adopts the following articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is:

GREATER JACKSONVILE NURSES REGISTRY, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing on the date of the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - NATURE OF BUSINESS

This corporation is organized for the purpose of providing home care assistance to clients and creating job opportunities for nurses and other home care givers, including providing job placement and any and all other legal activities associated with the aforementioned.

The Board of Directors is hereby specifically authorized to make provisions for the indemnification of Directors, Officers, Employees and Agents of the corporation to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XII - SHARES WITHOUT CERTIFICATES

The Board of Directors may authorize the issuance of some or all of the shares of stock without certificates. The Board of Directors and the corporation shall have all authority given under Section 607.0626(1) and (2), Florida Statutes, as the same now exists and may exist from time to time.
