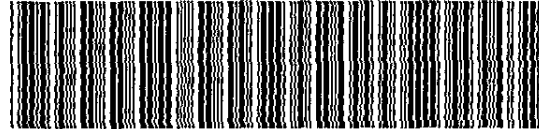


**ARTICLE III**
