To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed is a check for \$150.00 for the Uniform Business Report. I know that this payment is late, but I am asking for consideration and leniency due to an overwhelming personal matter that is the cause for the tardiness.

Seven (7) weeks of personal leave without pay was taken by me to be in New York for a family emergency. My sister was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at age 36 and was operated on immediately. My mother was unable to give care because my father had a debilitating stroke last year. I left Florida without hesitation and had all of my mail held by my neighbor. I am currently asking many other companies, such as mortgage, credit cards, utilities and the IRS for such leniency. I understand that my personal situation does not constitute such tardiness, but I am attempting to repair my business and personal matters.

Regrettably, I understand it is my responsibility to make sure these matters would be attended to before I left, but I departed without hesitation and felt I would deal with these matters upon my return. My financial situation has become very undesirable at this point.

This is the first time that I have been in this kind of situation and I am currently doing everything possible to reinstate my credit with many other companies. Would the state of Florida please take into consideration my plight and abate any penalties or fines and accept my payment of \$150.00? I would not ask if I felt this was done out of sheer neglect, but my personal situation dictated my actions.

I would be very grateful if the State accepted this arrangement so that I may regain a positive record with the State and the other companies involved.

Thank you for your consideration in this matter. If abatement is not feasible with the State, than can other arrangements be made to pay the amount that the State dictates? As a single parent I feel very irresponsible, but I would greatly appreciate a positive response in this matter. I would like to be informed as to your decision as soon as possible. Thank you again for your consideration in this matter.
