Seven (7) weeks of personal leave without pay was taken by me to be in New York for a family emergency. My sister was diagnosed with ovarian cancer at age 36 at was operated on immediately. My mother was unable to give care because my father had a debilitating stroke last year. I left Florida without hesitation and had all of my mail held by my neighbor. I am currently asking many other companies, such as mortgage, credit cards, utilities and the IRS for such leniency. I understand that my personal situation does not constitute such tardiness, but I am attempting to repair my business and personal matters.
