ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CEDAR KEY SEED, INC.



ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be CEDAR KEY SEED, INC.

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation by the SECRETARY OF STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is being organized for the purpose of growing, cultivating, harvesting, marketing, and in general engaging in the commercial oyster, clams and fish business and in the transaction of any and all business activities permitted under the laws of FLORIDA and the United States Of America.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation shall have the authority to issue 1000 shares of common capital stock, par value of \$1.00 each.
