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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PETER MARINO, INC.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is: PETER MARINO, INC.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction for any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the General Corporation Act of the State of Florida. These shall include but not be limited to, the power to sue and be sued, complain and defend in its corporate name in all actions and proceedings, and to have a Corporate Seal. It may take and alter by-laws in any way consistent with these Articles of Incorporation and the laws of the State for the administration and regulations of the affairs of the Corporation. The Corporation shall have the power to make donations to the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes. It shall have the power to transact any lawful business which the Board of Directors shall find to be in aid of Government Policy. The Corporation shall further have the power to pay pensions and establish pension plans, and other incentive plans for any and all its Directors, Officers and Employees and for any and all of the Directors, Officers and Employees of its subsidiaries. It may be a promoter, incorporator, general partner, limited partner, member, associate or manager of any corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture, trust or enterprise. The Corporation shall have the further power to purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge or otherwise dispose of and otherwise use and deal in and with shares or other interest in or obligations of other domestic and foreign corporations, associations, partnerships and individuals including the direct and indirect obligations to the United States or any

government, state, territory or other governmental body. The Corporation shall have the power to have and to exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect its purpose.

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation has the authority to issue is 100 shares, all of which shall be common shares with par value of \$1.00.
