ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the laws of Florida, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

 $\underline{\textbf{Section 1.1.}}$ $\underline{\textbf{Name}}.$ The name of the corporation is TYKA Insurance & Financial Services , Inc.

ARTICLE II

<u>Duration</u>

<u>Section 2.1.</u> <u>Duration</u>. This corporation shall exist perpetually.
