ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

VIRTUE, INC.

(a corporation for profit)

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit under the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of this corporation is VIRTUE, INC.
