

Article I.

Corporate Name

The name of this corporation is K. DOUGLAS BOWERS, DDS, P.A.

Article II.

Nature of Business and Powers

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this Corporation is to engage in the business of dentistry, investing this Corporation's funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other type of investments, purchase real and/or personal property necessary for the rendering of the professional services authorized by this Article.

Article III.

Capital Stock

The maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is 1000 shares of common stock having a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.

Article IV.

Term of Existence

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence commencing upon filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

Article V.

Pre-Emptive Rights

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this Corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without the issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

Article VI.

Directors, proposed by them to the stockholders and approved at a stockholder's meeting by at least a majority of the stock entitled to vote, unless all of the directors and all of the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of Incorporation be made.


