

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION MOOSHEIM, INC.



The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida: Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

- 1. NAME. The name of the corporation is: Moosheim, Inc.
