THE UNDERSIGNED do hereby associate together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida under the corporate name of LAURA FAIR PET AU PAIR, INC. and hereby set forth and declare:

CHARTER

ARTICLEJ

The name of the Corporation shall be LAURA FAIR PET AU PAIR, INC., located at Fort Myers, County of Lee, State of Florida.

ARTICLEJI

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

The amount of the capital stock of this Corporation shall be 100 shares of \$10.00 par value stock, which said stock shall be non-assessable to be held, sold and paid for at such time and in such manner as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine. All of the capital stock shall be common stock.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall commence business June 20, 2001.

ARTICLE Y

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence, except that the same may be dissolved, as provided

by law.

ARTICLE XIV

The initial By-Laws of this Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors. The By-Laws may be amended from time to time by either the shareholders or the Directors. The shareholders may amend, alter or repeal any By-Law adopted by the Directors.
