**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned incorporators hereby form and organize a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is **BIG OAK ENTERPRISES, INC.**

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the corporation is Route 10 Box 470, Lake City, Florida 32055, and the mailing address of the corporation is Route 10 Box 470, Lake City, Florida 32055.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

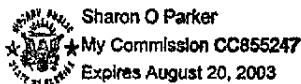
